Process for Accreditation of

Nursing and Midwifery Education B.E. 2560 (2017)

The on-going nursing education institution is mandated to submit its Self Assessment Report (SAR) 6 months prior to expiring date of accreditation announced by Thailand Nursing and Midwifery Council (TMNC).

(For example if the institution has to submit SAR on the third year 6 months prior to an expiring date)

- 1. The institution submit SAR to TNMC.
- 2. TNMC by Profession Standard and Accreditation Division appoint a subcommittee to review SAR.
- 3. The sub-committee for reviewing, of the SAR do the reviewing using the TNMC Regulation on Criteria for Accreditation of Nursing and Midwifery Education Institution B.E. 2560 (2017) as guidelines.
- 4. After the SAR reviewing; the sub-committee conduct assessment visit to the institution.
- 5. The sub-committee assess the Educational Nursing institution using Assessment Form for Accreditation of Nursing and Midwifery Educational Institution as guidelines.
- 6. The sub-committee record all data observed, scoring each item, calculate total score as guided by TMNC.
- 7. The sub-committee propose result to the Accreditation Committee for considering whether the institutional being accredited. The area for improvement has to be identified and notify to the institution.
